<b>Client Description:</b> CCS services can be authorized for children and young adults less than 21 years of age who have eligible medical conditions and whose families are unable to pay for all or part of their care.	
<b>Services Description:</b> In general, CCS covers medical conditions that are physically disabling or require medical, surgical or rehabilitative services. CCS also provides medical case management. Benefits of CCS include: Medical case management, referral to specialists and other agencies; diagnostic services to determine if child has a CCS medically eligible condition; treatment services to include medical care, emergency & hospital services, lab & diagnostic tests, medications, medical supplies & equipment, home health, glasses & hearing aids, dialysis, organ transplants, rehabilitation therapy services, medical transportation and much more.

<b>Client Description:</b> Butte County Public Health Clinics provides health promotion and illness prevention services for all ages and income levels. The clinic offers programs to assist with the cost of services to clients who meet the income eligibility.	
<b>Services Description:</b> The clinic services include: well-child exams, finger stick lead testing, immunizations-children & adults, foreign travel consultations & immunizations, cervical & breast cancer screening, family planning (birth control), pregnancy testing, HIV/AIDS counseling & testing, sexually transmitted diseases testing and treatment, Hepatitis B & C testing, TB testing, employment physicals, and drug/alcohol testing for employers.

<b>Client Description:</b> Butte County Public Health TeenSMART Program provides youth with an opportunity to learn more about their bodies and health by offering a comprehensive curriculum regarding valuable health related information and skill-building techniques to help them establish healthier choices. Youth participating in this program also do outreach to their peers, raising awareness of teen pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections, HIV/AIDS.	
<b>Services Description:</b> TeenSMART Peer Education Program is an outreach program that offers health related information, skill-building techniques and awareness of teen pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections and HIV/AIDS. Teens receiving 24 hours of training are referred to as Peer Educators. Peer Educators participate in outreach helping raise awareness among teens in their community and linking them to resources youth may be in need of.
