*Encourage our teens to take responsibility for their health and to adopt healthy attitudes & lifestyles.

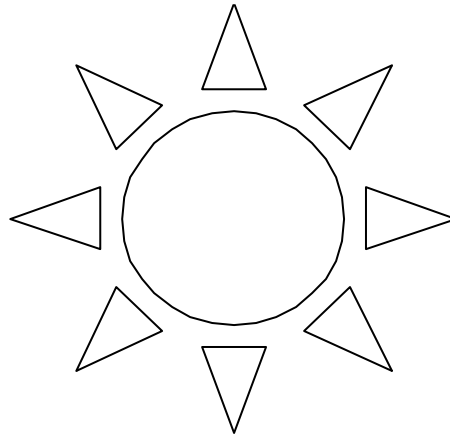
*Prevent the spread of disease, disability, injury, and premature death.

- *Family PACT* provides no-cost family planning services to California’s low-income men and women, including teens.

WHO’S ELIGIBLE?

- Teens are eligible if they are 13 years or older, make less than \$1,500 a month by them self, live in California and
- Do not have insurance that covers family planning **OR**
- Have insurance, but need to keep family planning services confidential
- **We keep all information and patient’s visit history confidential.**

- Information on Birth Control Methods
- Free Birth Control Pills, Patches, Shots, Rings and Other Methods
- Condoms
- Male & Female Health Examinations

- Emergency Contraceptive Pills
- Tests & Counseling for HIV/AIDS
- How to Say No to Sex When You’re Not Ready
- Preventing & Stopping Sexual Coercion
- Referrals to Counseling for Depression, Drugs & Alcohol
- Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening
